### **1. Audit Report 2010**

### **2. 2011 Budget**

And, funding tournaments based on the number of entries and reducing other items.

Chair, Dora Moutafian, distributed the Proposed Budget Report for 2011 which totals \$2680 a shortfall of about \$700 from 2010. According to Dora, we spent \$3,355 in 2010, but with membership down 20%, the budget for this year was reduced by that amount.

Best Ball Twosome Tournament (scheduled for June 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>) and because of budgetary considerations, this tournament has been canceled and will be replaced by another game TBD by the tournament chairs.
