RULES

Rule 27-Ball lost or out of bounds; Provisional ball:

If a ball may be lost outside a water hazard or may be out of bounds, to save time the player may play another ball provisionally. You must inform the players in your foursome that you intend to play a provisional ball and you must play it before going forward to look for the lost ball. If you fail to inform the other players and play another ball, that ball is now the ball in play under penalty of stroke and distance even if you find the original ball. If the original ball is not found the provisional ball becomes the ball in play under penalty of stroke and distance. If you find the ball and deem it unplayable you must proceed under rule 28, ball unplayable. You must then abandon the provisional ball. If there is reasonable evidence that the ball is lost in a water hazard, you do not play a provisional ball and proceed under rule 26, water hazards.
