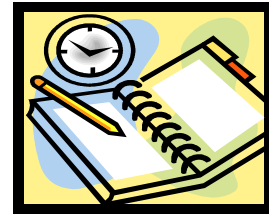

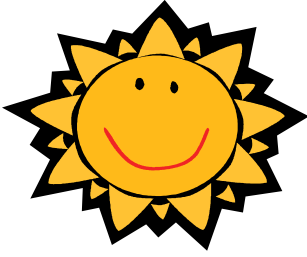


Birdie Board

It is a different and fun way to play golf

Since so many of us are involved with more than one club we would often find ourselves competing against Santa Teresa ladies who play for another club. This added to the jovial nature of the competition.
